What is the status of the Dual Credit courses?

When and how will I complete my courses?

- Course completion will occur online through your slc.me & Blackboard account.
- It is very important to sign in to your slc.me account and check your SLC email for messages from your SLC Instructor.
- Sign in to your Black Board account through slc.me for specific information on your course(s) and further instruction from your professor(s).

What if I decide I'm not able to complete my Dual Credit?

- Students can withdraw without academic penalty from their Dual Credit.
- In order to withdraw students must contact the Dual Credit Coordinator/Teacher (Kelly Pilgrim at pilgrimk@limestone.on.ca) or their home school Guidance Department.

How do I get an official transcript from SLC when my Dual Credit course is completed?

- Transcripts will be processed remotely. Any requests will be fulfilled by email with an
 unofficial transcript and a Transcript Validation letter. By collaborative agreement, these are
 being accepted by post-secondary institutions.
- Requests for transcripts to be sent to other post-secondary institutions or workplaces can be made by completing the transcript <u>request form</u>. Please include the recipient's email address. Return the form directly to <u>transcripts@sl.on.ca</u>
- Current students can access and print an unofficial transcript in slc.me. Current students can access and print a Verification of Enrollment in slc.me

How can I apply for a Dual Credit course in the Fall 2020?

- Students who have had their Dual Credits cancelled this semester, will have first priority for next year.
- DC Online application will be open soon TBD (around third week of April). Please contact your home school Guidance Department.
- Deadline for DC Applications will be Friday, Sept. 11, 2020.
- SWAC SWAC applications will close Friday, Sept. 11, 2020.
- No equal consideration date. We will take applications as they come in.
